JBL PROFESSIONAL ADVANCES LINE ARRAY OFFERING: ADDS NEW VRX918S SUBWOOFER TO CATEGORY-LEADING VRX SERIES PERFORMANCE LINE ARRAY

Incorporating principles from JBL's VERTEC® line array series, the VRX918S brings portable bottom end to small and mid-size venues.

LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, June 4, 2005 —In a move that provides significantly enhanced performance and flexibility to musicians, DJs, engineers and rental companies, JBL Professional today introduced the VRX918S subwoofer at InfoComm. The VRX918S is an 18-inch, 37 kg (81 lb) low-frequency speaker system, intended for use as a high-performance satellite subwoofer or as a building block for larger arrays. The introduction of the VRX918S comes on the heels of the VRX932LA, which brings the unmatched quality of JBL's VERTEC® line array series to small and medium-sized entertainment venues requiring shorter throw distances.

Acoustically identical to the SRX718S, the VRX918S is designed to meet the needs of users who wish to incorporate subwoofers into a flying VRX array. This is accomplished through suspension hardware modeled on the innovative design used for the VRX Series VRX932LA. The entire array can then be flown using JBL's VRX932LA-AF Array Frame.

The VRX918S is compact in size (20.0" x 23.5" x 29.5"), yet provides a power rating of 800W/1600W/3200W (Continuous/Program/Peak). The 13-ply birch enclosure is rigidly braced for solid response. Threaded insert points are provided for attachment of the optional WK-4 wheel kit.

Additionally, the VRX918S incorporates JBL's patented lightweight and high-power Differential Drive™ woofers, making the subwoofer extremely manageable. For added flexibility, the subwoofer retains the heavy-duty M20 pole mount receptacle for ground-stacked applications.
