STUDIO BERAR FIELDS MASSIVE JBL VERTEC® LINE ARRAY SYSTEM FOR SERBIA'S 2007 EXIT NOISE SUMMER FEST

NORTHRIDGE, CALIFORNIA, July 19, 2007 — Reinforcing JBL Professional VERTEC® line arrays as the most powerful and versatile in the industry, Studio Berar recently deployed a live sound reinforcement system for EXIT Noise Summer Fest, the largest music festival in southeastern Europe. The annual festival once again took place at a striking, historical castle fortress in Novi Sad, Serbia.

Each year, a youthful audience, drawn by an entertaining environment and some of the world's most prominent artists, comes from different parts of the country and throughout Europe. Attendance has increased each year since 2001, with 35,000 attendees at the main stage this year.
